2018 Budget Hearing/Annual Meeting Minutes September 17, 2018

The 2018 Annual BudgetHearing / Annual Meeting was held at the Reedsville High School Library at 7:00 P.M. on Monday, September 17, 2018 with 10 electors present. Board President Andrew Maertz led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The 2018 Budget Hearing /Annual Meeting of the Reedsville School District consisting of the Villages of Reedsville and Kellnersville, Towns of Cato, Cooperstown, Franklin, Kossuth, Maple Grove and Rockland, Manitowoc County, and Town of Morrison, Brown County, was called to order at 7:00 P.M. by Board President Andrew Maertz. Mr. Maertz opened up nominations for a temporary chairperson.

Rick Hein was nominated by Carie Boldt. Motion made by Tony Butturini, seconded by Vicki Petska. Rick Hein was elected temporary chairperson.

Minutes of the 2017 Annual Meeting werepresented by Vicki Petska, Board Clerk. A motion to approve the minutes was made by Tony Butturini, seconded by Andrew Maertz, Motion carried.

The Annual School Report, which outlines the year's activities, was presented by Andrew Maertz.

Carie Boldt, Board Treasurer, presented the Independent Auditors Report and the Annual Treasurer's Report.

Rick Hein then introduced Superintendent Tony Butturini, who explained the budget for the 2018-2019 school year. He also explained projected 2018-2019 revenue estimates, revenue limits, budget information and the tax levy on various home values. Mr. Butturini explained the various revenue and expenditure funds and their purpose in the school budget accounting system. Mr. Butturini discussed the purpose of financing remodeling, maintenance, repair, and improvement projects at district buildings.
