High School students should have received communication and materials for completion of 3rd quarter courses. If you have any questions about the 3rd quarter please email your student's teachers for clarification on remaining work.

For 4th quarter, most of our students will begin utilizing an online platform called Buzz provided through BYU. We have used this platform before and have been working to ensure our transition is as successful as possible. In order to set-up our students in this learning platform we need **ALL HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS** to complete a 4th quarter registration form:

We need all of our high school students to register through the form for 4th quarter classes because we are not able to provide every class as scheduled for the 4th quarter (i.e. Tech Ed classes). **Please complete this registration by 11:59pm on Sunday,**

March 29th. Students will be loaded into the Buzz platform with courses starting on Wednesday, April 1st.

The instruction that will occur in Buzz will be asynchronous, which means it can be completed at any point and will pace itself to each student's needs. All courses completed at the high school level will count for credit towards graduation and will be reflected on the student's GPAs.

Students will receive their login information on March 31st for the Buzz platform through their school email accounts. If you have any questions or concerns about this instructional delivery, please email me and our staff will work with you to resolve all issues.
